On the similarity between the leafhopper faunas of Yakutia and the northern part of North America (Homoptera, Auchenorrhyncha)

The generic composition of the leafhopper faunas of Yakutia (NE Asia) and northern part of North America (Alaska and Canada) is compared using the recently published monographs (Sivtsev & Vinokurov, 2002; Maw et al., 2002).

These territories are located at approximately the same latitudes. They were connected in the past through Beringia, which allowed faunal exchange, also of leafhoppers. Fifty-three genera are common to these territories, as follows:

- family Cixiidae: Cixius;
- family Delphacidae: Achorotile, Criomorphus, Javesella, Kelisia, Megamelus, Nothodelphax, Ribautodelphax, Unkanodes;
 - family Aphrophoridae: Lepyronia, Neophilaenus, Philaenus;
- family Cicadellidae: Aphrodes, Athysanus, Balclutha, Cicadula, Colladonus, Cosmotettix, Coulinus, Deltocephalus, Diplocolenus, Doratura, Elymana, Euscelis, Hardya, Hebecephalus, Idiodonus, Limotettix, Macrosteles, Mocuellus, Paluda, Platymetopius, Psammotettix, Rosenus, Sorhoanus, Stenometopiellus, Thamnotettix, Cicadella, Evacanthus, Idiocerus, Macropsis, Oncopsis, Aguriahana, Alnetoidia, Arboridia, Chlorita, Dikraneura, Eupteryx, Forcipata, Notus, Typhlocyba, Zygina.

Although the number of common genera is large, the number of common species is relatively small.
